

CYRIL GRAY TOURNAMENT 2022

Terms of Competition

1. Form of Competition

The form of play is scratch foursomes match play with each match consisting of three separate foursomes matches. Each player must be more than 50 years old by the first day of the tournament.

Each team match is to be played out until two pairs have won two matches. Halved matches have to be played out until one team has two wins.

If a team of six players cannot be raised for either the main event or the plate the school concedes the round.

2. Order of Play and Time of Starting

Team Captains (or, if not present, another member of the team) must hand their pairings in order of play to the Committee Member in the Entrance Hall of the Clubhouse at least half an hour before their match is due to commence.

In the event that details of a team's complete pairings are not handed to the Committee Member in the Entrance Hall of the Clubhouse half an hour before their match is due to commence the Committee Member on duty will, at their discretion, determine the pairings.

The team and order of play cannot be changed after it has been submitted. The time of starting for the first game of each match is shown on the Drawcard. Subsequent games are expected to start at 6 minute intervals. The player striking the tee shot at the 1st hole must present themselves to the Starter at the 1st tee 5 minutes prior to the time of starting. His/her partner may wait in a position where the tee shot might be expected to finish, however they must be present on or near to the 1st hole when the tee shot is struck.

3. Advice

Although there is no objection to teams having non-playing Captains if so desired, the Committee have decided that advice may only be given to a player by their partner or their caddies.

4. Buggies

Powered “ride on” buggies (as distinct from powered trollies) may not be used in any circumstances.

5. Distance measuring devices

The use of distance measuring devices is permitted in accordance with a local rule that will be posted in the Clubhouse.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Photographs

Team captains are requested to ensure that their full team is available at the first tee at least five minutes before they are due to start in the first round to assist in the taking of the team photograph.

2. Practice

Practice during the actual tournament is to be confined to the practice ground or practice putting green. The Club Office will control the practice ground and will issue buckets of balls.

3. Refreshments

The Bar on the course will be adjacent to the 10th green.

4. Car parking

There will be considerable pressure on car parking space. Please therefore endeavour to share cars as much as possible and please comply with the directions of the car park attendants on arrival.

5. Towels

Please note that the Club’s supply of towels is limited and it is therefore suggested that players bring their own towel. Please notify your team members accordingly.
